Come along with your kids to the Raffle Stall in the Hall to see the prizes on offer, and to buy tickets (which will only be available on the day). Anyone can enter but the prizes will cater specifically for children, with the 'grown-up' prizes staying in the regular Raffle. We hope the children will enjoy a prize draw designed specifically for them!

NEW for 2018 - Professional Photography Stall at the Fair
