

## Boost your donation by 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate.

If you're a UK taxpayer, using Gift Aid means that for every £1 you give, the school can claim another 25p from HM Revenue and Customs. Gift Aid is reclaimed by the school from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.
