National Assessments

As an infant school, we have a number of statutory assessments that we have to complete with the children at specific times of the school year.

Year Two – end of KS1 Assessments

During the month of **May**, children in year 2 take part in the end of key stage assessments. These statutory assessments support the teacher assessments which are made and reported to parents towards the end of the children's time in year 2.

Year 2 parents have already been invited to a workshop to explain more information about these assessments, but if you have any further questions, please do speak to your child's class teacher directly. Year One and some Year Two pupils - Phonic Screening Check

All children in year one will be taking the Phonic Screening Check in the week beginning **Monday 12th June**. The check will also be taken by some of our year two children (those who have not taken the check before or those who did not meet the threshold in year one)

EYFS Profile

As the children in Reception reach the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage, they will be assessed by staff within each of the 17 areas of learning against national requirements (Early Learning Goals – ELGs). Parents will be informed as to whether their child is 'emerging' or 'expected' within each of the areas. Children are defined as having reached a Good Level of Development (GLD) at the end of the EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level for the ELGs in all of the prime areas of learning and the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

Results of all of the above assessments will be reported to parents in the children's annual school reports.

Annual School Reports (ALL year groups)

All parents will receive a written report before the end of the summer term. This report will highlight the achievements and general progress that your child/children has made throughout the year as well as their attendance record. Should you wish to discuss your child's report with their class teacher, you will be able to arrange a meeting with them following receipt of your child's report

We would like to invite **ALL** children and their families back to school on this special annual evening to visit their classes and their current class teacher to share and celebrate the children's hard work and success throughout the year. Children who are remaining at Maple next year will also have an opportunity to visit their new classroom.

Please be aware that if your child attends Maple Stars, then you will need to collect them from the club at 5pm so that you can attend this event with them – Maple Stars staff will be unable to visit the classes with the children.

We look forward to welcoming you to this exciting event and celebrating your child's successes and achievements.

Social Media Communication

We know that class WhatsApp groups and similar can be a wonderful way for parents to keep in touch with each other and can be used really effectively. Whilst the school are not party to any of these communications, we have recently been made aware of a number of inappropriate communications that are being sent.

Families have raised concern with the school and we are therefore reminding our parent community to ensure that **any** communication is respectful and appropriate and if there are any concerns regarding school, that these should be reported directly to the school as soon as possible so that we can take any necessary actions.

<u>Attendance</u>

At Maple, we promote excellent school attendance for **all** pupils to ensure that they reach their full potential and as part of this commitment, we have previously held an ambitious attendance target of 97% or above (Reception – Year 2). We have set a target of 96% this year to help us to work towards achieving this target again.

As we move into the summer months, we are seeing attendance slowly improving overall, which is really positive (it is now 94.8%). However, we are still receiving a number of requests for absences and so we would like to remind families that as outlined in our school policy 'the head teacher will not grant any leave of absence to pupils during term time unless they consider them to be exceptional circumstances'.

In addition to this, if a pupil's attendance is already at or below 90%, then any leave of absence, except for medical reasons, will automatically be unauthorised.
