A Nurturing Environment



The children will continue to explore the Nursery environment and play with their friends and the adults working with them. The children will be encouraged to learn the names of their friends and use their names when talking to one another. During the first half term the EYFS team will work hard to develop confident, strong relationships with the children so they feel settled, happy and ready to learn through play.

Communication and Language

The children will begin to sing nursery rhymes during daily rhyme time, they will be encouraged to use language to explain their ideas and feelings. The Nursery team will work with your children to support them in using expressive language and short, full sentences when they are talking. Nursery children will listen to at least 3 stories a day and we would encourage you to read a bedtime story every day to encourage a love for reading.

Physical Development

The children will explore the outdoor environment, including the climbing frame and large physical development space. They will practise climbing, sliding, crawling and using scooters and bikes.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will begin to explore turn taking, talking about how to share resources fairly and working with a grown up to solve problems they may encounter. We will encourage the children to develop confidence and independence during snack time, working together as a Nursery team to help one another.
