We will continue to settle the children into the Nursery environment and embed the daily routines that take place during a Nursery session.

A Nurturing Environment



The children will continue to gain confidence in the setting. We will talk about how we feel at Nursery thinking about times when we are happy.



Communication and Language

The children are really enjoying listening to stories and talking about them with their adults and peers. We will continue to learn new nursery rhymes including 5 Currant Buns, Miss Molly and Baa Baa Black Sheep. We will start to think about which songs and stories we like best, we will choose stories and songs for our friends to listen to together. We will be focusing on the following stories:

- One Mole Digging a Hole
- Monkey and Me
- Max the Brave
- Dear 700

Physical Development Playdough is an excell

Playdough is an excellent way to encourage your child's physical development. Due to the restrictions in place in school we are unable to use playdough at Nursery at this current time. We will be starting to practise our scissor skills and use glue to make collage pictures. We will practise joining materials using tape and glue, thinking about which materials stick best. We will also continue to learn movement songs.

The children will continue to develop friendships with their peers, playing together and sharing fairly. This week we will learn how to be a good friend. We will also learn the words to the friendship song and learn to sing the finger family songs.
