Nasal Flu Vaccination – November 3rd 2022

All parent and carers have been sent, via ParentMail, information with regards to the nasal flu vaccination programme, managed by Schools Health Team, which is available to all children Reception – Y2.

Please complete the form sent to you as soon as possible to accept or decline, with all forms needed to be received by 31st October.

Should you choose to have your child receive the vaccine in school you will receive an email acknowledging that the vaccine has been given. The details of the vaccine (Name, Batch, Expiry Date) are entered onto the Schools Health Team system and information sent to your GP.
