PE and Sport Grant 2017-18

The government has provided additional funding to each school annually since 2013 to support and improve the provision of physical education (PE) and sport. For this academic year (2017 – 2018) the DfE have confirmed that this funding will be doubled. The funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on ensuring that schools make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer, although schools have the freedom to choose how they should do this. Ultimately this means that the premium should be used to:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers
- make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

Maple Infants' School has received the following PE funding:

- £8750 for 2013/14
- £8895 for 2014/15
- £8810 for 2015/16
- £8810 for 2016/17
- Approximately £17630 is expected to be issued for 2017/2018

At Maple Infants' School we recognise the contribution of PE to the health and wellbeing of the children. In addition, it is considered that an innovative and varied PE curriculum and extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the concentration, attitude and academic achievement of all children.

We aim to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision by:

- continuing to extend our PE provision and offering a range of PE opportunities for all pupils
- continuing to deliver inclusive high quality PE sessions
- increasing opportunities for pupils to take part in competitive sporting events
- increasing staff confidence and subject knowledge
- updating resources and introducing our children to a wider range of equipment and activities

Below is a table of planned spending for 2017-18.

This is particularly important for many of our children and families as many of our families live in accommodation within our community which does not have safe outdoor spaces for children to play in at home (as evidenced by our home visits). This will also support our pupils to be independent and take responsibility for looking after equipment which links to our school's Golden Rule: 'We look after property'.</i></p>	
<p>Kingston Schools Sports Partnership Membership (KSSP) £483.00</p>	<p>To secure and enrich the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision and to increase participation in PE and Sports so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach performance levels that they are capable of.</p> <p><i>This will provide the Subject Leader for PE increased opportunities for CPD and networking with other PE coordinators from across the Kingston borough, including any feeder schools. It will also ensure that our pupils are able to participate in competitive activities and access the calendar for local competitions appropriate for infant aged pupils within the academic year.</i></p>

This coaching is continued for pupils who attended our Nursery and will support the children to continue to inspire their interest and enjoyment in sport activities alongside developing their skills further.</p>	
<p>Improvements to EYFS outdoor area £10,000</p>	<p>To secure and enrich the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision and will make improvements that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.</p> <p>All pupils within our EYFS will leave the Foundation Stage with improved levels of physical development by significantly improving the outdoor space and creating increased opportunities for promoting the development of gross motor skills– including removing the current climbing frame and replacing it with more up-to-date/challenging equipment for the children to use.</p>	
<p>Sports coach 1x day a week for Years 1 and 2 £7,980.00</p>	<p>To secure and enrich the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision and make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.</p> <p>Every child within Key Stage 1 will access weekly coaching from Pleiades Leisure which will enhance and develop their skills and enrich the quality and breadth of the provision. Teachers will work with coaches to develop their own confidence and skills when teaching PE which will</p>

Development of playground outside Copper Beach /Sycamore class £1,000	To increase participation in PE and Sports so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach performance levels that they are capable of. <i>Installation of a climbing wall for children to use along the side of the school building will provide our pupils with a new activity to participate in and will be situated in an area of the playground which will encourage the children's physical activity during lunch times.</i>	
Gymnastics CPD for KS1 staff £500(tbc)	To secure and enrich the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision to benefit pupils now and in the future. <i>Providing professional development opportunities for staff specifically targeting gymnastics will support the teaching of this area of physical education.</i>
