PE Sessions

PE sessions will continue in Reception this week, children will need to come to school in their PE kit (**red shorts/ black or navy tracksuit bottoms, PE t-shirt, plimsolls and school jumper/cardigan**) on the following days each week:

meditation. We will celebrate every member of our class by talking about why we are all special.

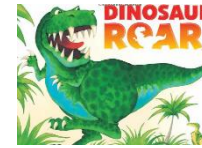
Phonics and early language skills

Our phonics sounds for this week are **i, n, m and d**. We will continue to focus on the tricky words **I, the, to, no, go and into**. Please use the flashcards sent home on Friday 2.10.20 to help your child practise reading these words and sounds.

Reading

We will be focusing on a different text each day that links with our phonics sound:

- It Could Have Been Worse
- Naughty Bus
- Monkey and Me
- Dinosaur Roar



The children will complete activities linked to these stories in continuous provision, these activities will develop their skills in reading, communication and language, physical development and expressive arts and design.

Early mathematics

The children will continue to experience high quality mathematics activities in class. This week children will be encouraged to seek out independent maths in the classroom, hunting for numbers and matching objects to a given amount. The children will continue to experiment with mark making to record numbers and learning more number rhymes and stories.
