Uniform

The children are looking very smart in their school uniforms. As you are aware, our school uniform plays a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of our school and I would like to thank all of our families in advance for your support ensuring that your child/children come to school in the correct school uniform. For this academic year the children are able to attend school in either our previous uniform (available at half price from the school office) or our new uniform (available from PPG in Tolworth).

Please can we ask families to ensure that their child/children attend school wearing the correct footwear. They should be wearing sensible black closed toe shoes. Trainers, boots, flip-flops or fashion footwear are not permitted.

PE kit

Please also make sure that your child has the correct PE kit in school as they will not be able to take part unless they have the appropriate kit.

Year Group Welcome Meetings

Each year group team will be holding a 'Welcome Meeting' for parents during the first few weeks of term. This provides families with an opportunity to meet the teachers and find out what your child will be learning about. You will also have an opportunity to ask any questions. These meetings will be held in the school hall at 2.30pm on the following days:

For parents who are unable to attend these meetings, any handouts will be sent to you after the event and any direct information will be placed on our website.

'Dahlicious Dress Up Day' – Friday 16th September

We are celebrating the work of Roald Dahl between Monday 12th and Friday 16th September. On Friday 16th September we will finish our week by inviting all of the children to come to school dressed as their favourite Roald Dahl character or the children may wear anything yellow as this was Roald Dahl's favourite colour. We will also be using this day to raise money for Roald Dahl's Marvellous Children's Charity which helps to make life better for seriously ill children in the UK. We would welcome any donations which families would like to make (the suggested donation from the charity is £1 per pupil). Many thanks in advance for your support.

Attendance

We are striving to ensure that every child reaches their full potential at Maple Infants' School and ensuring that children attend school on time and regularly is part of our commitment in partnership with families. We will therefore be continuing to regularly monitor children's attendance to school. Our Education Welfare Officer (EWO) supports the school and families when the absence of a pupil is lower than expected and the EWO will make contact with families if absence is a significant concern. As well as continuing our half termly attendance awards we will also be introducing a weekly class award for the class with the best attendance of that week. This class will then look after our attendance mascot 'EDI' – Every Day's Important. We understand that from time to time children can be poorly and need to miss school to recover or attend medical appointments, however any other absence requires advance permission from the school and absence requests will only be granted in exceptional circumstances. This information is the most recent information which we have regarding your child. Could you please check that all of the information is correct and let the school office know as soon as possible if any details need changing. These include your contact numbers and it is really important that these are up to date so that we could contact you in an emergency.

Celebration Assemblies

When your child celebrates their birthday we will invite you to join us for our celebration assembly, generally on the Friday of the week of their birthday. The office will let you know of the date when we will celebrate your child's birthday. For Reception the assembly will be at 9.05 – 9.25am and the timings for the Year 1 and 2 assembly will be 2.45-3.10pm. We also invite families to donate a book to the school if they would like to on this day.
